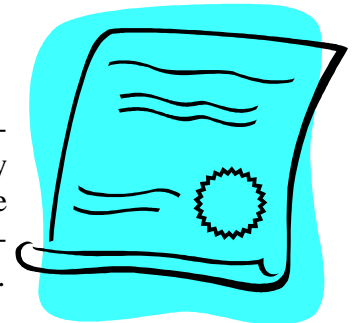
Town of Lexington Business License FYI

The Town's Business License Ordinance requires any individual, corporation, or other entity, "engaged or intending to engage in any calling, business, occupation or profession" within the Town to obtain a business license.

When considering how the business license requirements apply in your situation, please keep the following in mind:

- The requirement to have a license applies whether or not you have a physical location within the Town.
- In-home businesses require a special permit in addition to the business license.
- Ownership of commercial rental property requires a business license.

- Ownership of residential rental property totaling more than five (5) dwelling units requires a business license.



You *may* be able to lower your license fee by obtaining separate licenses for distinct activities of your business.
