- (B) The applicant shall agree to fully indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Lexington and the State of South Carolina from any and all claims, demands or actions for damage to persons or property that may arise, or alleged to have arisen, on account of the location or maintenance of the traffic obstruction(s) to which this Permit applies.
- (C) Upon notification this permit may be cancelled due to non-compliance for reasons concerning traffic safety.
- (D) This permit shall be available on site at all times.
- (E) Required to maintain proper traffic control including advance warning signs and flagger(s)
- (F) Required to maintain flow of traffic at all times.
